# **Melbourne Conference 2012:**

Even though it was a year ago, I would like to thank everybody involved in presenting papers and organizing a wonderful conference in Melbourne last September. Around 70 delegates attended and, from the pre-conference drinks on Wednesday night at the NGV to the gallery crawl on Saturday afternoon, were treated to a variety of scholarly and creative experiences in some of Melbourne's most interesting venues. The painting studios and the Margaret Lawrence Gallery at the Victorian College of the Arts, the Australian Centre for Contemporary Art, the Royal Society of Victoria, the State Library of Victoria and a number of artist run initiatives provided a window into Melbourne's rich art culture for interstate delegates and international speakers.
